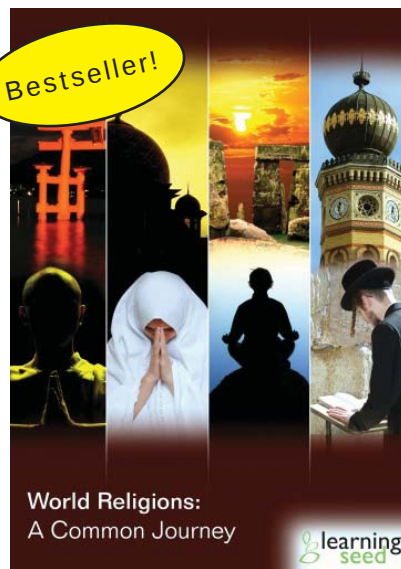


almost automatic need to group people into categories and to identify clear "us" and "them" groups.
